



Check-In & Dismissal

Ministry: Good News Club

Volunteer Role: Check in & Dismissal

Purpose Statement: Assist kids with checking in at the beginning of Good News Club; Help parents to check out kids during dismissal

Responsibilities:

- Be present on a consistent basis; missing a club should be an exception
- Arrive early for prayer and to help with set up; stay to help clean up
- Provide a friendly face- making them feel welcomed and being there to greet them and assist them
- Keep up with check-in sheets and name tags
- Track and report attendance
- Facilitate dismissal, focusing on building relationships with parents
- Help students & parents leave Good News Club each week with a smile on their face

Time Investment: Approximately 2-4pm, once per week

Commitment: Weekly during the school year (September -March/April)

Requirements:

- Be a Christian pursuing a growing relationship with Jesus, which includes consistent prayer, Bible reading, and connections with other Christian peers
- Background Check/Application/Approval
- Child Evangelism Fellowship Statement of Faith agreement
- Online New Volunteer Orientation (approximately one hour, whenever you are able)
- Annual in-person training (one day, 8:30am-12:30pm)
- Monthly training videos and enrichment via email and private Facebook group
