LESSON 1—The King Has Spoken! (Evangelistic Narrative—TCE 1)

Scripture: Jeremiah 36:1-32; 2 Peter 1:21; 2 Timothy 3:15

Memory Verse: Isaiah 40:8

KJV “The grass withereth, the flower fadeth: but the word of our God shall stand for ever.”

ESV “The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever.”

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe the Bible is the true Word of God, trusting in Jesus for salvation.

Main Teaching: The Bible is God’s true message to you.

Emphasis for Saved: God speaks to you through the Bible.

Word Up!: The Bible is true!

LESSON 2—The King Creates! (Evangelistic Doctrinal)

Scripture: Genesis 1:1-2:4

Memory Verse: Genesis 1:1

KJV “In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.”

ESV “In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.”

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will trust Christ as his Savior, recognizing God as the one who created, loves, and saves him.

Main Teaching: You can know God the Creator King.

Emphasis for Saved: You can worship God the Creator King.

Word Up!: God is the Creator King!

LESSON 3—Sin Enters the King’s World (Evangelistic Narrative—TCE 1)

Scripture: Genesis 3

Memory Verse: Ephesians 2:8

KJV “For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God.”

ESV “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God.”

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will believe on Jesus as the only one who can save him from sin’s punishment.

Main Teaching: Believe on Jesus to save you from sin.

Emphasis for Saved: You are free from the power of sin.

Word Up!: Jesus can make me free from sin!

LESSON 4—How to Come to the King (Evangelistic Narrative—TCE 1)

Scripture: Genesis 4:1-16; Genesis 3; Hebrews 11:4; 1 John 3:12

Memory Verse: Ephesians 2:8-9

KJV “For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.”

ESV “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.”

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will put his faith in Jesus, who reverses the effects of sin and gives eternal life.

Main Teaching: Faith is the only way to come to God.

Emphasis for Saved: Obeying God shows your faith.

Word Up!: Come to God!

LESSON 5—The King Saves (Evangelistic Narrative—TCE 1)

Scripture: Genesis 6-8; 9:12-17; 2 Peter 2:5

Memory Verse: Ephesians 2:8-9

KJV “For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.”

ESV “For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast.”

Teaching Objective: The unsaved child will recognize God’s salvation plan is for him and will trust in Christ.

Main Teaching: God, who is just, can save you from sin.

Emphasis for Saved: The Holy Spirit lives in you to help you listen to and obey His Word.

Word Up!: God can save me!

LESSON 6—Creation Celebration (Review Lesson)

This fun, interactive review lesson with a science theme highlights some fun facts about God’s Creation and a scientist whose faith in God led him to great discoveries. Use the suggested pictures and activities to keep the children’s interest as you share about the wonder of God’s creation and the love He has for people. Remember to share the Gospel Spotlight, “Gravity and the Gospel,” and the Growth Spotlight, “George Washington Carver,” which contains the teaching for the saved child. Help the saved children see that they can use their talents for God.
